


# **Wolfe Island**



### **Wolfe Island**

Experience the beauty and tranquility of island life – by bike and enjoy a ride exploring Wolfe Island, the largest of the 1000 Islands, located where Lake Ontario ends and the St. Lawrence River begins. From the ferry docks in Kingston, roll on board for a short free ride over to Wolfe Island, disembarking at dock in Marysville or nearby. Stop in town for picnic or beach supplies before pushing on along quiet country roads, past the endless green fields, through the peaceful island setting following the Great Lakes Waterfront Trail.

Wind your way along the south side of the island with views across the river to nearby New York State. Marvel at the tall wind turbines that dot the island, one of Canada's largest wind farms. Stop at unique artisan and agricultural businesses along the way. Add a ride out to Big Sandy Bay and hike 1.5km hike to the spectacular sandy beach. Cool down in the waters of Lake Ontario before continuing the ride, cycling back to Marysville to visit local bakery, gallery, pub and museum or stay overnight before a return ferry to Kingston.




Wolfe Island (Summer Ferry) - Cycling Itinerary


Wolfe Island (Seasonal Ferry) - Cycling Itinerary













# **Places to Stop**

- Waterfront, bakery, restaurants and attractions, Marysville
- Waterfront and downtown Kingston
- Wolfe Island Gallery
- Old House Museum/
   The Tiner LaRush House
- Wolfe Island Wind Farm Information Kiosk
- Point Alexandria, Horne's Ferry and view to Cape Vincent, New York
- Big Sandy Bay and beach

- Start in alternate locations: Marysville, elsewhere on Wolfe Island or Kingston
- Option to add ride and hike to Big Sandy Bay and beach
- Combine this itinerary with other cycling routes in and near Kingston

# **Logistics**

#### Route

- Some sections of gravel roads
- Smaller quieter secondary roads
- Flat
- Suitable for all types of bikes

#### **Cautions & Notes**

- Wolfe Island vehicle traffic can be heavy during summer weekends and holidays, especially close to ferry arrival and departure times, on roads to and from ferry
- There are two ferry docks: in Marysville for summer ferry service and 4km east of Marysville for seasonal ferry service. Dock in Marysville will become permanent year round dock when construction is complete, seasonal dock is in use until then.
- Many businesses have varied seasonal hours or may be closed outside of summer months, check online in advance
